



Skipper – Category E

Obtain your skippers certificate of competence for Inland waters and 1 nautical mile offshore for small power driven vessels. Certificates are issued by SAMSA after completion of the course.

The course consists of theory, exam and practical test.

Theory training

The theory part of the course takes about 4 hours to complete with a written exam and practical to follow.

The course is presented from 18h00 – 22h00 during the week or on a weekend from 09h00-13h30 at our offices in Lynnwood depending on the size of the course or at other venues. The cost for the full course is

R3000 and upgrade from Category R to E is R1650. It includes all you course materials & SAMSA registration fees. To complete your forms for this license we will need +25hrs coastal experience, medical & eye test form, 2 copies of id & 4 id photo's.
